Once at the Lincoln Blvd. kiosk, ask for directions to Lot A (aka Hannon Lot). Once parked, walk due north through the lot, then onto the sidewalk between dorms and soccer field. At the end of that walk is the Burns Arts Center. No signs are visible on this approach though one of the individual building names, Hogan Hall, is visible up to the left.

Accommodations

Food

The **Lair Marketplace** in Malone Hall includes grill, soup counter, salad bar, fresh sandwich counter, sushi (in packages, but not bad), and seductive desserts.

QCT (quick/close/tasty) off-campus lunch alternatives include Viva Fresh (about 2' drive once in your car), and Szechuan Palace (about 5' from campus). Maps will be at the registration table.
